# **Front Trailing Arm Front Bush**

#### **INSTALLATION GUIDE**

### **Product description:**

This part replaces OEM part number C2D6343

### **Contents (parts per pack):**

2 x A bushes

4 x B bushes

2 x stainless steel sleeves

1 x grease



Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- all safety precautions adhered to;
- wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.

All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

## **Fitting Instructions:**

- 1. Remove the front bush from the front trailing arm.
- 2. Clean any dirt/rust from the bore of the arm. File away the sharp edges from the bore. Fig A
- 3. Insert the new 'A' bush into the inner side bore of the arm by applying some washing-up liquid to help the bush slide through easily. Push bush all the way through till it is locked in properly. Fig B.
- 4. Apply some of the supplied grease to the bore of bush A.
- 5. Insert 'B' bushes into both sides of 'A' bush. Apply some of the supplied grease to the bore of the bush and insert the sleeve into the bush. Fig C.
- 6. Re-fit the rear trailing arm to the car and tension all hardware to manufacturers recommended torque settings.
