

FRONT ANTI ROLL BAR LINK ROD BUSH

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Product description:

PFF3-213 Replaces the bush in the alloy bracket which joins the front anti roll bar to the lower arm, it will not fit the bracket which has a ball joint at each end.

Contents (parts per pack):

PFF3-213

- 4 x bushes
- 4 x metal sleeves
- 4 x washers
- 1 x grease

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;

- all safety precautions adhered to;

- wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.

All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Remove the bracket from the car.
- 2. Remove original bushes from the bracket, clean the bore of the bracket.
- 3. Lubricate the out side of the new bush with washing up liquid and push into the bracket, *tip hold the bush at an angle to the bracket to get the bush started in the hole.*
- 4. Apply some of the supplied grease to the bore of the bush and push the stainless steel sleeve through
- 5. Bolt the bracket back onto the anti roll bar and lower arm fitting the washer to the free face of each bush
