### UPPER ENGINE MOUNT INSERT

#### **INSTALLATION GUIDE**

## Contents (parts per pack):

1 x Part A Polyurethane Bush 1 x Part B Polyurethane Bush

1 x Part C Polyurethane Bush 1 x Grease

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any
- -All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

# Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Support the engine from the bottom of the car and remove the upper engine mount.
- 2. Clean any dirt or corrosion and remove any flash lines from the voids of the mount.
- 3. Apply some supplied grease into the voids and insert Part A into the voids from the side away from the mounting bracket (Figure 3).
- 4. Fit Part B into the top voids closer to the mounting bracket (Figure 3).
- 5. Slide Part C from top of the mounting bracket and lock the pins of Part C into the pin holes on Part A to secure the two together.
- 6. Re-fit the upper engine mount to the vehicle.
- 7. Tension all hardware to manufacturers recommended torque settings.




Figure 2 - showing how A and C polyurethane inserts should fit together




Figure 3 - exploded view showing where all inserts fit inside the upper engine mount
